

Frequently Asked Questions

Why do I need to get a Vulnerable Sector Police Information Check?

- It is a requirement as we serve a vulnerable population.

Do I have to pay for the Vulnerable Sector Police Information Check?

- Yes, the cost is covered by the volunteer. However, there is a volunteer discount available, reducing the fee to \$20.00.

I already have a Vulnerable Sector Police Information Check, can I use it?

- Yes, we accept Checks done within the past six months.

I have young children who would like to volunteer with me, am I able to bring them?

- Absolutely! Please indicate this on your application.

Do you accept volunteers under 16 years old?

- Yes, but they have to be accompanied by a sibling that is 16 years or older or someone who is 18 years or older who can undergo a Vulnerable Sector Police Information Check. Both the youth and chaperone will need to fill out separate application forms.
