

# Planting Days FAQ

## 1. Do I need to bring my own tools and gloves?

Volunteers are encouraged to bring gardening gloves or small hand tools, although supplies will be provided if needed.

## 2. I don't have much experience gardening – is this ok?

Absolutely - we are in this together! No previous experience needed! Between volunteers, staff and GEF seniors we will do our best to ensure the success of the garden spaces.

## 3. Are children welcome to participate?

Children are welcome to assist during Planting Day, provided they are supervised by an adult.
